## **SANCHEZ RESIGNS FROM CONGRESSIONAL HISPANIC CAUCUS**

**WASHINGTON**— Congresswoman Loretta Sanchez (D-CA) issued the following statement in response to her resignation from the Congressional Hispanic Caucus.

*“Today, I resign from the Congressional Hispanic Caucus, chaired by Mr. Baca.*

*Last year, I and other Members of the Caucus voiced our strong opposition to Mr. Baca’s chairmanship due to a violation of election rules. An official response to our inquiry is still in question.*

*I will continue to be a strong and vocal advocate for the Hispanic community and serve as the Chairwoman of the Banking and Finance Committee for the Congressional Hispanic Caucus Institute, a non-profit organization.”*
